REQUIREMENTS FOR BOARDING:

1. All animals must be current on all vaccinations, including canine influenza. Written proof of vaccinations or verification with the pet's veterinarian must be provided before boarding the pet(s).
2. If parasites are found on the pet during the stay, they will be treated as Southside Animal Hospital determines, and the cost of the treatments will be added to the total bill.
3. If a tranquilizer is necessary for treatment or handling, Southside Animal Hospital has my permission to administer such medication.
4. Pets may be picked up after 2 pm Monday through Friday, or before noon on Saturday. There is no Sunday drop off or pick up. Boarding fees are charged on a per night basis.
5. Your pet will receive a complimentary bath on the day they are scheduled to leave. However, if the pet's health or temperament makes it hazardous to the staff or the pet, the pet will not be bathed. If you DO NOT wish for your pet to receive a bath, please check here. _____
6. All pets remaining after 14 days from their discharge date will be considered abandoned. Southside Animal Hospital is given permission to dispose of the pet(s) as they deem best. You must call immediately if you should need to leave your pet longer than what is scheduled.
7. If any problems develop:
 - Please treat my pet as required, you do not need to call me before beginning treatment. I agree to pay all charges incurred by this selection.
 - Perform only emergency and supportive care. Notify me for permission to begin any other treatment. I agree to pay all charges incurred by this selection.
 - Do not perform any diagnostics/treatment (even life-saving) until I am notified and consent to the treatment as recommended.

POLICY AND DISCLAIMER:

Pets, by their nature, are often times nervous, hyper-excitabile, and don't always use good judgement. Hence, they sometimes injure themselves while playing with other pets or over-react to being enclosed. Some examples are, but are not limited to: torn nails, bitten lips or tongues, broken teeth and damaged intervertebral discs (hurt back).

All reasonable precautions will be used to prevent injury and escape of the pet. Southside Animal Hospital is not responsible for the actions of the pet that may cause injury and escape (including possible death).

I understand that my pet is in a social situation much like a human day care and that infectious problems are impossible to eliminate. I understand that you cannot guarantee the health of my pet. I will not hold Southside Animal Hospital responsible for conditions that often are unavoidable in boarding environments such as, but not limited to, weight loss, hair loss, cough, bloat, diarrhea, upper respiratory tract infections and parvo virus. I understand that some diseases are airborne and do not require direct contact with other pets, and that some infectious pets are often not obviously infectious.

I understand that Southside Animal Hospital is not responsible for loss or damage to personal items left with the pet including but not limited to leashes, collars, toys, and bedding. I agree to pay all charges incurred during my pet's stay, including all treatments agreed upon by me.
